1 Complete the Challenge.

Create a device that will capture or trap something in a way that doesn't cause it any harm.

The Rules	
You CAN:	You CAN'T:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Make the trap any shape or size. ✓ Make it as simple or complex as you want. ✓ Use anything/anyone you want as your trapee - as long as you don't hurt them. ✓ Use any materials you want. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Use a premade trap or a trap bought from a store. ✗ Use your hands to stuff your trapee into the trap. You actually have to trap it! ✗ Use dangerous materials that can harm your trapee (or anyone else).
<p>Once you have a working trap, try testing a completely different solution. What are the important elements of a successful humane trap?</p>	
 Our tips to avoid angry parents 	
DON'T	DO:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Trap your pets. That's not nice.  Use someone else's things without asking.  Trap someone without warning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Get permission to use your trapee and materials of choice.  Keep your trap away from live animals when you're not using it.  Clean up after yourself.

2 Create a video of your Humane Trap.

Try to keep your video under 90-seconds long and include the following:

- The name of your solution.
- How does it work?
- What materials did you use?
- Did you have to overcome any problems?
- What was the biggest lesson you learned?
